Governors' Bursaries are awarded at the discretion of the Headmaster, with the support of the Board of Governors of St. Michael's Preparatory School.

The Awards are means tested and made to pupils (not currently at St. Michael's) going into Year 7 with the intention of following secondary school education on-island. Governor's Bursaries are worth 100% of school fees.

The selection process will involve a further interview with the Headmaster and Assistant Heads. The date and timings of the interview day will be confirmed at a later date.

The awarding of this bursary brings many new opportunities and challenges, but also the responsibility to set and maintain the highest standards at all times. In conferring awards, we look for gifted individuals who will be a credit to themselves and the School.

A Governors' Bursary is held subject to a pupil maintaining a good standard of endeavour and conduct during their time at the School. Bursaries are subject to annual review and there is an expectation that a bursary recipient will set an example in the way in which they approach their studies. All bursary holders will play an active role in the life of the School.

The Board of Governors reserve the right not to make an award, or indeed to withdraw an award, if a recipient falls short of the School's standards. Bursaries awarded at 11+ are tenable until the end of the Shell Year at St. Michael's Preparatory School.
